### **Traditional Paschal greeting:**

**COMMEMORATION:** Mathias Fortini, requested by Roxas Family

**Liturgical Notes:** The Easter troparion is sung at the beginning of each service during Paschaltide, first by the priest, then by the faithful. Then the priest sings the first part, and the faithful respond with the ending *"and has given life to those who were in the tomb."*

The troparion is sung after Holy Communion, and then again (thrice) at the end of the Liturgy, in place of *"Blessed be the name of the Lord..."*
